### HOW WE HELP



We performed the first-ever **health needs assessment** benefiting the 1,500 people who are homeless in Santa Monica.

Creating Opportunities for Physical Activity program has served **8,500 students** in 17 elementary schools from South Bay's low-income neighborhoods.

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## A TRADITION OF CARING

When the Sisters of Providence arrived in the Pacific Northwest in 1856, they came to answer a call for help from a new pioneer community. What they found were many communities in need of service, and so with dedication and collaboration, they built the first schools, hospitals and orphanages in the West. Their ministry grew to what is now a five-state health system. We continue the tradition of caring that the sisters began nearly 160 years ago, always keeping in mind the most poor and vulnerable.

## WHERE WE SERVE

Providence Health & Services in Southern California serves the Los Angeles County region of South Bay, Westside and the Greater San Fernando Valley. With more than 13,500 caregivers (all employees), we operate six award-winning hospitals in addition to a full spectrum of care that includes a network of nearly 50 primary care clinics with our affiliate Facey Medical Group. We also operate the well-regarded Providence Medical Institute physician group, numerous outreach programs serving those in need, hospice and home care including TrinityCare and TrinityKids Care and even our own Providence High School, a college-preparatory school.

Providence in California is part of the third largest not-for-profit health system in the nation which also serves communities in Alaska, Oregon, Montana and Washington. Our combined scope of services include 34 hospitals, 475 physician clinics, long-term and assisted living, palliative and hospice care, home health, supportive housing and education. In 2014, Providence provided a total of \$848 million in community benefit.
